

GROUP CRISIS INTERVENTION

This 2-day course is designed to present the core elements of a comprehensive, systematic, and multi-component crisis intervention curriculum.

- Elements of the CISM strategic planning formula
- Informational vs. interactive groups
- The need for appropriate follow-up services and referrals

- Demobilizations
- Defusings
- Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD)


